2020 Challenge

Sunbonnet Sue for the 21st Century

Make a wall hanging (finished $16" \times 16"$) updating Sunbonnet Sue. She has to be a woman that looks and acts like a woman of the 21^{st} Century.

The rules:

- She has to have a new name. It must have alliteration and is two words. For example, Texting Teresa, Rapping Rose, Facebook Fannie, etc.
- Her name will explain what she is doing.
- Her name must be visible on the front of the quilt
- Her face cannot be visible
- She must wear a hat
- The wall hanging must be quilted
- No larger than 16" x 16"
- It can be appliqued, pieced or whatever method you choose.
- There must be a pieced border using HSTs (half square triangles) and a binding.

All wall hangings are due the Friday (set up day) before the quilt show. The quilts will be displayed by the Community Service table at the quilt show. There will be 2 quilt racks displaying the quilts. These quilts are not to be registered with the other quilts in the show. If you bring your quilt on the Friday and it meets the qualifications it will be a part of the competition.

Voting will begin Saturday at the show and end at 2pm Sunday. Winners will be announced after the votes are counted.

First place is \$60.00, second place \$30.00 and third place \$15.00.
