

Guidelines for Community Service Projects

Baby Blankets

- Must be at least 36" long and wide (can be larger but not smaller)
- Must be 2 layers of flannel or 1 layer of flannel and 1 layer of cotton.
- If you use fleece, the edges must be finished with crochet or binding. If the piece is too small add enough binding or edging to make it 36".
- No selvage edges should be seen on the finished blanket, either fleece or flannel.
- **Please check for pins**
- If you do not have enough flannel for a blanket, piece sections to make it long and/or wide enough. One side can be flannel and the other can be cotton. Piece a long piece of scrap flannel to measure at least 80" long, fold it in half and sew it together to make a blanket.
- Knitted or crocheted blankets must be 36" as well.
NO PREMMIE HATS or KID HATS. Hats should stretch to fit a newborn head.
